## Workshop: Basics of Fashion Drawing

### OUTLINE:

This course teaches basic drawing skills of fashion drawing beginning with 2 minute random sketches from a live fashion model to help define movement, proportion, and perspective. Students learn to see the silhouette of the figure and of clothing through color blocking with pastels which helps the student arrive at the desired contour line fashion drawing necessary for communicating their ideas for fashion designs on paper.

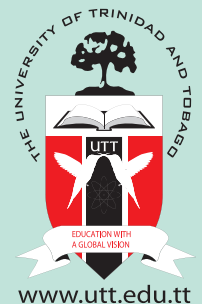
### OBJECTIVES:

At the conclusion of the workshop, students will be able to draw a fully clothed fashion figure as a way to communicate their ideas for fashion designs on paper. This can be useful to professionals or future CAFD candidates in preparation for the submission for entry into next year's CAFD fashion design programme.
