OUTLINE:

This course provides details of the process and guidelines to organizations on the planning and conducting of emergency exercises using the table top model aimed at building capabilities to prepare, respond and recover from emergency and crisis situations. It provides the techniques that are required to conduct individual exercise activities working with both internal and external agencies and entails practical exercises.

- Implement the application of the exercise process through simulated exercises
