

# PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION UNIT (PEU) HEALTH AND SAFETY DEVELOPMENT SERIES SMALL COMMERCIAL VESSELS OPERATING IN THE CARIBBEAN SEA - BOAT MASTER CATEGORY II

## OUTLINE:

The Boat Master License replaces the Launch Captain's License. The governing Act (Motor Launches Act) is to be repealed and replaced by Regulations under the revised Shipping Act. These Regulations will give effect to the SCV Code for vessels under 24 meters in length (200 GT), operating in the Caribbean Sea.

The course provides participants with the necessary training to take operational command of such vessels and crew in the Conduct of Safety of Life at Sea, Prevention of Pollution and the observance of the National Shipping Laws of Trinidad and Tobago.

## OBJECTIVE:

At the end of this course successful candidates will be eligible for the granting of a Boat Master's License Category II from the Maritime Services Division and be certified to command vessels up to 24 meters in length.

## DESIGNED FOR:

Persons required to take charge of vessels up to 24 meters in length.

## CERTIFICATION:

Participants will be awarded a Certificate of Training.
