OUTLINE:

The Boat Master License replaces the Launch Captain's License. The governing Act (Motor Launches Act) is to be repealed and replaced by Regulations under the revised Shipping Act.

This course provides training for persons to take command of OPEN vessels under 24 meters operating in Protected and Coastal Waters of not more than 20NM from a safe haven.



OBJECTIVE:

At the end of this course successful candidates will be eligible for the granting of a Boat Master's License Category III from the Maritime Services Division.



DESIGNED FOR:

Persons required to take charge of open vessels up to 24 meters in length.

CERTIFICATION:

Participants will be awarded a Certificate of Training.
