About UJN

- Shandong Province, located in east of China, is the home town of Confucius and the cradle of Confucianism. It's the third largest economic province in China.
- Jinan, the capital city of Shandong province, is also called the "city of springs". As a national famous historical and cultural city, it adjoins Mountain Tai, a world cultural and natural heritage, and Yellow River, the Mother River of China.
- University of Jinan is a key and comprehensive university in Shandong Province with a history of 75 years. It is entitled a distinctive institution of higher learning which is committed to cultivating applied-talented students. It offers bachelor's, master's and doctoral degree programs and enjoys the right to recommend postgraduates exempting admission examinations.
- University of Jinan has four campuses, covering an area of over 2.43 million square meters. It has 26 schools, and 3 post-doctoral research center. There are ten kinds of major specialties, namely Economics, Law, Education, Literature, History, Science, Technology, Management and Art. Six disciplines, such as Chemistry and Material Science, are taken into the Essential Science Indicators (ESI) database, ranking in the top 1%.
- University of Jinan has promoted policies of opening-up and internationalization. It has established international cooperative relationships with 120 international counterparts in countries including the U.S., U.K., Germany, France, Canada, Australia, Russia, Japan, South Korea, Singapore, etc. Up till now, more than 4000 international students have graduated from the university.

Non-Degree Programs

Chinese Language and Culture Program

Based on your Chinese level, there are 6 different levels from the very beginning to advanced, there are about 20 credit hours language courses per week, plus some cultural courses in the afternoon.

Main courses: Speaking, Listening, Grammar, Reading and Writing.

Selective courses: Chinese Culture, Chinese Calligraphy, Traditional Dance, Chinese Painting, Peking Opera, Tai Chi, Tea Art, Paper Cutting and HSK tutorial etc.

Scholarship Programs @ UJN

1. Chinese Government Scholarship

Bilateral Program

Supporting Categories: Chinese Government Scholarship programs sponsor international students, teachers and scholars to undertake degree studies (bachelor, master and PhD) and Chinese language study or academic research in institutions of higher education in China.

Scholarship: Scholarship covers tuition, accommodation, medical insurance and living allowance.

Applicants should apply to the dispatching authorities for overseas study in their home countries between January and early April. Please contact the dispatching authorities for the specific deadline of each year.

Chinese University Postgraduate Program

Supporting Categories: Doctorate and Masters Candidates.

Scholarship: Scholarship covers tuition, accommodation, medical insurance and living allowance.

2. International Chinese Language Education Scholarship

Programs: Master and Bachelor degree of TCSOL (Teaching Chinese to Speakers of Other Languages); Chinese Language and culture (one-academic-year or one-semester programs)

Scholarship: Scholarship covers tuition, accommodation, medical insurance and living allowance.

Applicants: Currently enrolled students in Confucius Institutes

3. Shandong Provincial Government Scholarship Program

Supporting Categories: Doctorate, Master, Bachelor Candidates or language learners.

Scholarship: Scholarship covers registration, tuition, accommodation, medical insurance and monthly stipend.

4. UJN President Scholarship

Supporting Categories: Doctorate and Master Candidates.

Doctorate Candidates: Scholarship covers tuition, accommodation, medical insurance and a monthly stipend of CNY2000.

Master Candidates: Scholarship covers tuition, accommodation and medical insurance.

5. UJN Undergraduate Scholarship

Supporting Categories: Bachelor Degree Candidates.

Scholarship: Scholarship covers 50% tuition and 50% accommodation.

Applicants: For majors taught in Chinese, students might be supported to study for a one-year Chinese language program under this scholarship.

Admission Requirements

1. About Applicants

Applicants must be non-Chinese nationality, physically and mentally healthy, aged between 18~40 for degree study and 18~60 for non-degree study, with high school degree or above.

2. Language Requirements

(1) Students applying for English taught programs should come from countries where English is the mother tongue or official language, or graduate from English taught major or have English language proficiency of IELTS 5.5/ TOEFL 80 or above.

(2) Students applying for Chinese taught programs should have Chinese language proficiency of HSK4 and above.

3. Application procedures and required documents

(1) Please apply on the site <http://admission.isao.ujn.edu.cn/>.

(2) Required documents (All documents should be in/translated into Chinese or English)

Each applicant should submit his/her

- ① Application form (please fill all the applicable items);
- ② Scanned copy of passport (expiration more than 18 months);

③ Notarized Graduation certificate and full set of transcript of highest degree, or study certificate (if not graduated);

④ Physical examination form

For those who graduate more than two years

⑤ Certification of latest employment (if formally employed) or certificate of non-criminal records (if unemployed in recent years).

In addition, students who apply for degree programs must provide the following documents:

Bachelors Candidate

⑥ For Chinese taught program, the language requirement is HSK level 4 or above.

Postgraduate Candidate

⑥ Study Plan;

⑦ Two letters of recommendation from two associate professors or higher;

⑧ For Chinese taught program, the language requirement is HSK level 5 or above.

NOTE: If students are currently studying in China, please add the following documents

① Graduation Certificate or Study Certificate and Transcript from previous school;

② Scanned copy of information page of passport and the page with entry stamp, residence permit page or X2 visa page;

③ Transfer Letter or Certificate of Completion and transcript from prior institution.

2. How to apply

1) If you apply for the Chinese government scholarships, please visit <http://www.campuschina.org> and apply for the scholarship by reference to the application instructions within the time limits. After application, please re-apply on <http://admission.isao.ujn.edu.cn/>, or you will not be admitted.

2) If you apply for other programs, please apply on the site <http://admission.isao.ujn.edu.cn/>. For online registration, please refer to the online application instructions for international students.

3. Evaluation

1) Applications for Chinese government scholarships will be evaluated by CSC and UJN.

2) Applications for International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarships will be evaluated by Hanban and UJN.

3) Applications for other scholarship and self-paying students will be evaluated by UJN.

4. Admission

Accepted international students will receive the Admission Letter of UJN and Form JW201 (for Chinese Government scholarship students) or Form JW202 (for other program students). With these materials (original form), the applicant may obtain an X1 visa (study over 6 months) or an X2 visa (study less than 6 months) on request from the local Chinese Embassy or Consulate.

5. Registration

After enrolling and paying the required tuition, applicants should finish the procedures for residence in China in Jinan Exit-Entry Administration Bureau within 30 days (Materials required include the passport, Admission Letter, Visa Application Form for Foreigners, and Verification of Physical Examination for Foreigners).
