2. Possess the following qualifications: An academic degree (earned in the United States or abroad) equivalent to a U.S. bachelor's degree completed by September 30, 2015		
3. Intend to devote yourself full-time to the proposed academic plan during the fellowship year		
4. Intend to return to your home country to pursue a professional career		
5. Be proficient in English		
6. Master's/first professional degree and doctoral applicants must have applied by December 1, 2015 to an accredited institution of study for the period of the fellowship year and must indicate the name of the institution in the International Fellowship application		
7. Postdoctoral applicants must provide proof of their doctorate degree; hold a doctorate classified as a research degree or an M.F.A. by December 1, 2015; and indicate where they will conduct their research.		
8. Master's/first professional degree and doctoral applicants must be enrolled in a U.S. accredited institution located in the United States during the fellowship year
