Byelaw 1: Divisions of the Student Guild at UTT (UTTSG)

1. Divisions of the UTTSG is divided into the following classes:
 - 1.1 The Executive Student Guild (ESG)
 - 1.2 The Chapter Guild.

The ESG

2. The description, powers and authority of the ESG not mentioned within the UTTSG constitution shall be as follows
 - 2.1 The colours used by the ESG for uniform, logo, letterheads and all other official capacities shall be a combination of red, white and black.
 - 2.2 The motto shall be "Strength in Unity, Truth & Tenacity. One University."
 - 2.3 The logo used by the Executive Student Guild is prescribed as follows:
 - 2.3.1 The logo shall have the words '*Student Guild at The University of Trinidad & Tobago*' at the top and the Student Guild's motto at the bottom.
 - 2.3.2 The logo's design shall be three interlocking arms to represent strength in unity and the circular formation of the arms representing tenacity. The arms shall be red, white and black respectively, to represent our status as student representatives of the National University. Around the arms, shall be gold stars representing each main campus of UTT.

The Chapter Guild

3. The description, powers and authority of the Chapter Guild not mentioned within the UTTSG constitution shall be as follows:
 - 3.1 The UTTSG Chapter Guilds are as follows:
 - 3.1.1 Academy for the Performing Arts Campus and Performing Arts programmes referred to as the APA Chapter Guild.
 - 3.1.2 Camden Campus and the Aviation programmes referred to as the Camden Chapter Guild
 - 3.1.3 Chaguaramas Campus and the Maritime and Marine programmes referred to as the Chaguaramas Chapter Guild.
 - 3.1.4 Corinth Teacher's Campus and the Education and Sports Programmes referred to as the Corinth Chapter Guild.
 - 3.1.5 Eastern Caribbean Institute of Agriculture and Forestry and the Agriculture programmes referred to as the ECIAF Chapter Guild.
 - 3.1.6 John S. Donaldson Technical Institute and the Fashion and Technology programmes referred to as John D Chapter Guild.
 - 3.1.7 O'Meara Campus and Biomedical Programmes referred to as the O'Meara Chapter Guild Student Guild Chapter.

 - 3.2.6 John D. Chapter Guild – Maroon.
 - 3.2.7 O’Meara Chapter Guild – Royal Blue and Yellow.
 - 3.2.8 Point Lisas Chapter Guild – Lime Green.
 - 3.2.9 San Fernando Chapter Guild – Teal.
 - 3.2.10 Tamana Chapter Guild - “Chapter not officially established as of effective date of the byelaw.”
 - 3.2.11 Tobago Chapter Guild – Yellow.
 - 3.2.12 Valsayn Chapter Guild -Orange

- 3.3.10 Tamana Chapter Guild - "Chapter not officially established as of effective date of the byelaw."
- 3.3.11 Tobago Chapter Guild – Tobago Wolves.
- 3.3.12 Valsayn Chapter Guild -Leo-Valsayn Lions
- 3.4 The Logos used by the UTTSG are detailed as follows:
 - 3.4.1 APA Chapter Guild – the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of a Phoenix of the colors red and gold representing fire and ashes. The Word APA should be on top and the word PHOENIX shall be at the bottom of the design.
 - 3.4.2 Camden Chapter Guild – "Chapter not officially established as of the effective date of the byelaw."
 - 3.4.3 Chaguaramas Chapter Guild – the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of four sharks: A great white shark at top; A hammerhead shark at right; A Manta Ray at bottom; A bull shark at left. Each representing the various disciplines at the Chaguaramas Campus. The Sharks shall originate from the center of the drawing with a blue ocean splash enclosed by a brown Captains wheel bearing the words 'Chaguaramas Campus' at top and 'Home of the Chag Sharks' at bottom.
 - 3.4.4 Corinth Chapter Guild – the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of a gladiator merged with St. Thomas Aquinas, carrying a torch in the right hand and a book in the left hand. This design represents the merger of Education and Sports programs at the Corinth Campus. The Words 'CORINTHIANS' at top and 'FEARLESS WARRIORS' at bottom. Use of colors red black and gold
 - 3.4.5 ECIAF Chapter Guild – the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of a Bull encompassed by three black rings used to depict agricultural science. The Words 'ECIAF' at the top and 'RAGING BULLS' at bottom. Use of colors green and black.
 - 3.4.6 John D. Chapter Guild – the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of a kneeling Knight on the word 'KNIGHTS' with the letter 'D' on its shield held in the left hand of the knight and a Sword held in the left hand goes through the word 'JOHN'. The words 'THE UNIVERSITY OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO' at top and 'STUDENT GUILD' at bottom. Use of the colors maroon, grey and black.
 - 3.4.7 O'Meara Chapter Guild – the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of an eagle's head striped in gold with a royal blue outline. The words 'O'MEARA EAGLES' at bottom.

- 3.4.8 Point Lisas Chapter Guild – the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of a gladiator holding a spear and a shield standing as a Giant on an industrial estate. On shield there are drawings of an Oil Rig and three barrels and the words ‘ENERGY GIANTS PT. LISAS’ at bottom. Use of Lime green and red.
- 3.4.9 San Fernando Chapter Guild – the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of an oil well drill going through the words ‘SFTI’ then ‘DRILLERS’, arched by a gear wheel at top. Use of colors Teal and white.
- 3.4.10 Tamana Chapter Guild - “Chapter not officially established as of effective date of the byelaw.”
- 3.4.11 Tobago Chapter Guild – the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of the head of three wolves beneath a sun. at top the words ‘THE UNIVERSITY OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO’, ‘TOBAGO CAMPUS’, ‘Est. 2011’ and ‘#1’. At bottom the words ‘Tobago Wolves’, ‘Our Motto: To live, love, learn, laugh, let, listen, lead, and lobby’, and ‘STUDENT GUILD ©’. Use of colors yellow and black.
- 3.4.12 Valsayn Chapter Guild - the design shall incorporate an artist depiction of the head of a lion. The words ‘Valsayn Campus’ at top and ‘Lion Pride’ at bottom. Use of colors orange, gold and black.
