

UTT Advances the Local Maritime and Marine Sectors

The University of Trinidad and Tobago's (UTT) Centre for Maritime and Ocean Studies (CMOS) is home to a suite of degree programmes catering to the developmental needs of the marine and maritime sectors locally, regionally and internationally. To aid in this

development, several of UTT's Maritime and Marine Sciences programmes received specialised international accreditation from the Institute of Marine Engineering Science and Technology (IMarEST) for the maximum period of five (5) years. Through accreditors like the IMarEST, students

and faculty members are provided with ongoing professional development opportunities and mentorships that allow for effective participation in cutting-edge research, thus facilitating sustained capacity building and technology transfer. CMOS continues to expand its global

reach with a view to sustaining research and development imperatives for the marine and maritime sectors.

Driven by a robust research agenda, UTT is the proud host of the Maritime Technology Cooperation Centre Caribbean (MTCC Caribbean) one of five such centres established worldwide under the Global MTCC Network (GMN) Project of the International Maritime Organization. The GMN Project is funded by the European Union and aims to build capacity for climate mitigation in the maritime industry. Through the MTCC, UTT is:

- Providing a platform for partnerships in enhancing energy efficient methods in the maritime domain at a global level and specifically in the Caribbean region.
- Identifying environmentally friendly and sustainable technologies available to the region.
- Enhancing awareness and uptake of environmentally sound technologies and expertise within the Caribbean region.
- Providing advisory and market development services for technology adopters and suppliers.
- Monitoring regional energy efficiency needs and aligning training programmes to meet those needs.

Through MTCC Caribbean, UTT will create the first baseline of maritime energy efficiency in shipping in the Caribbean.

As the national University, UTT continues to position itself as a leader, offering quality tertiary education in a number of diverse disciplines, all of which are aligned to the developmental pillars of Trinidad and Tobago.

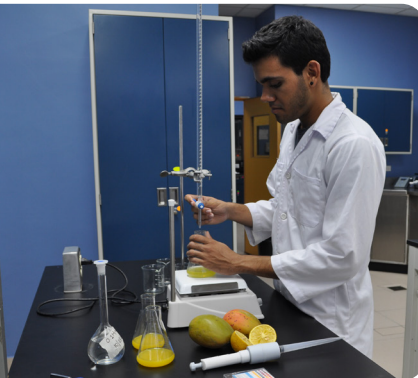
