What is a QR Code?

A QR code is a machine-readable code or type of barcode, for storing information that can be easily and instantly read by a digital device, such as a Smartphone.

How does a QR Code work?

A QR code stores data in a square-shaped grid, which is translated when scanned into information that the user can easily understand. For example, it can direct the user to a website (such as UTT Libraries) or a payment page. QR scanners are built into most smartphones; if not, the user can download a QR reader/scanner application

How to read a QR Code using your smartphone?

Step 1- Open the camera or the QR application on your smartphone

Step 2- Point the camera at the QR code

Step 3- The data stored on the QR code will be shown instantly on your smartphone screen.
