The UTT community is encouraged to search, browse and use the database to aid in teaching, learning, research and individual development.

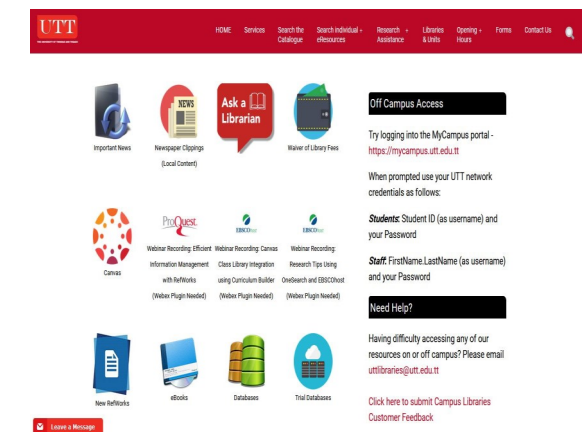
## SUGGESTED USES FOR THE NEWSPAPER CLIPPINGS DATABASE

## ACCESSING THE NEWSPAPER CLIPPINGS DATABASE

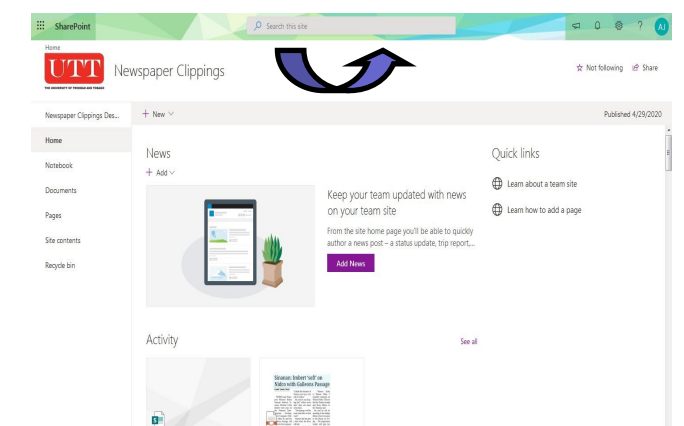
- ♦ Go to **UTT Libraries** homepage at <https://www.u.tt/library>



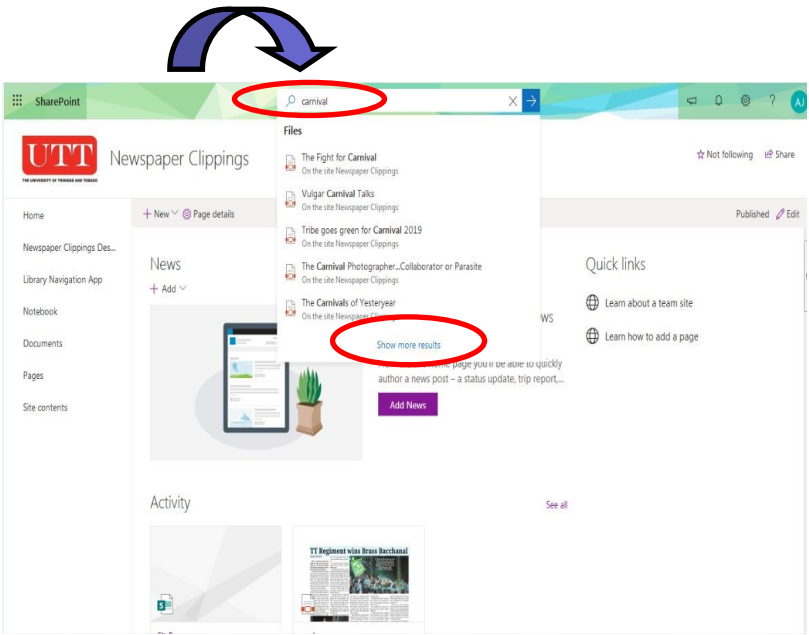
- ♦ Click the newspapers icon



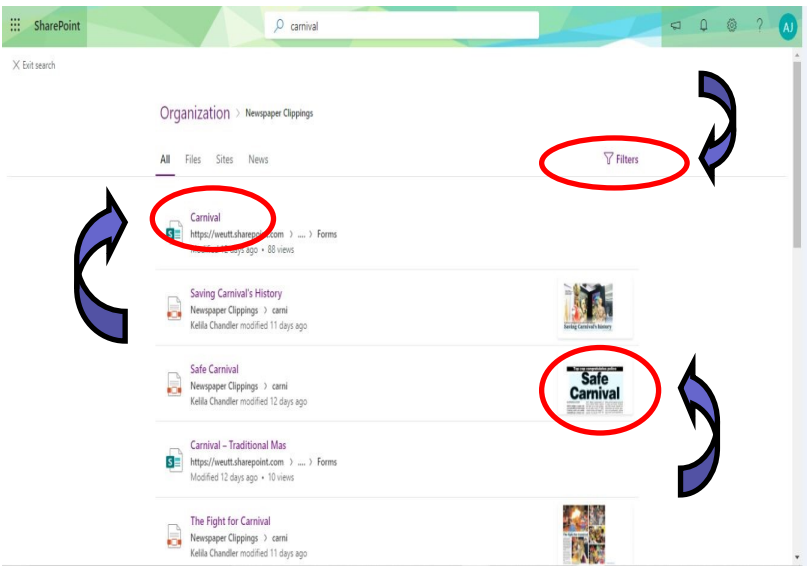
- ♦ To do a search, enter your search term/s in the search box at the top of the page.



- ♦ For example to do a search for articles on **“Carnival”**.
- ♦ Type **Carnival** in the search box.
- ♦ From the drop down results list click on an article or **“Search More Results”**.



- ♦ Click on **article title** or **image** to **view** full text, and /or **print**, or click on **Filter** to filter by **date modified**.
