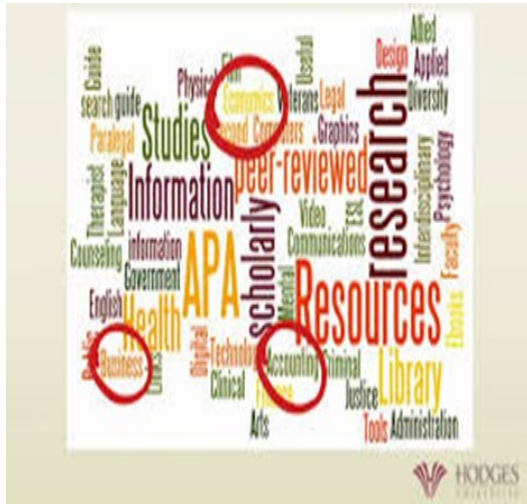

Utilise the Ask a Librarian Chat



UTT Libraries *Ask a Librarian Live Chat* service is available Monday through Friday.

Library Website

UTT OneSearch

You can access all of UTT's resources in a single search using "UTT OneSearch" facility. You can search by Keyword, Title or Author.

Search the Catalogue

To browse the print and multimedia collection, click on the "Search the Catalogue" tab on the menu bar or access the *Catalogue* directly using the link <https://utt.on.worldcat.org>

From the *Advanced Search* field the *Search Index* allows you to search by Keywords, Title and Author.

Accessing Databases

To access the *Databases*, click on the "Search Individual e-Resources" tab on the menu bar and select *Databases* from the dropdown menu. Scroll down to view the listing.

or

Click on the "Database" icon on the homepage.
