# The Moriche Palm

Called the “tree of life” by the Tamanac indigenous people, the Moriche Palm was first documented in 1595 by English navigator and poet Sir Walter Raleigh (1552-1618) when he explored the coast of Trinidad. Later, Swedish naturalist Carl Linnaeus named the palm *Mauritia flexuosa*. This elegant and majestic tree can grow to a height of 35 metres, making it an easy focal point in its natural setting.

The Moriche Palm is integral to the natural setting of Tamana InTech Park, the site of UTT’s Signature Campus. The image of the Moriche Palm is prominently displayed on the exterior of all UTT campuses.

# The University Mace

Traditionally, a mace is a staff carried by a dignitary as an ensign of individual or institutional authority and prestige. The University of Trinidad and Tobago’s Mace represents the standing of the University and the power of higher education not only in shaping lives but also in improving society.



# Graduation Robes

UTT's graduands are outfitted with robes that are cut along traditional lines with tucks and tiny buttons along the bell-shaped sleeves. The colours have been chosen to reflect the Caribbean heritage and aesthetic.

Graduates receiving Ph.D. degrees are adorned in **BLACK**, which is reminiscent of the richness of the soil that anchors us as we grow in strength as a nation.

Those awarded postgraduate degrees wear **RED**; a colour that represents the vivacity of our people.

Students receiving Bachelor degrees are enrobed in **GREEN**, which signifies the lush foliage that grows abundantly in Trinidad and Tobago.

Diploma graduands use **BLUE** - the colour of the water that surrounds our twin-island Republic.

Recipients of UTT's Certificate programmes are enrobed in **BURGUNDY**, boldly representing the start of their journey in tertiary education.

All graduation robes are adorned with the Moriche Palm on the left shoulder and the National Flag of Trinidad and Tobago on the right shoulder.

Gregor Breedy's many achievements as choreographer, dancer and teacher, in addition to his successes in the Prime Minister's Best Village Trophy Competition and other roles, propelled him to enrol at The University of Trinidad and Tobago (UTT). He graduated with a Master of Arts (M.A.) in Carnival Studies, with his thesis examining Limbo dancing, its origins, development, and future role in the Caribbean.

His research was completed with a different focus, pathway and emphasis on approach and methodology embedded in social theory, and called for a wide array of approaches which stressed performances, audience participation, and interviews with dancers from various backgrounds. Gregor applied the theory of the French folklorist Arnold Van Gennep to Limbo, delineating and utilising the ceremonial stages of a ritual as "rites" that display "preliminal, liminal and postliminal" stages.

Gregor was not only able to depict the origins of the dance in West Africa, but to also uncover the many unusual steps and movements within the dance itself, and the many contributors from Trinidad and Tobago, who have by way of themes involving captivity, colonisation, imperialism, colonialism, resistance and redemption, contributed to making Limbo a stamp that reflects Caribbean History in its many facets and features. Moreover, he brought to dance, dance promoters, lecturers and teachers, a special consciousness which enlightened their teaching and practices, and which elevated dance and dance legacy to a high level of pride, and its dancers to greater self-esteem.

Gregor, however, did not stop there. Focusing on both qualitative and quantitative approaches in his writings, he sought to recommend to the powers that be, the need to revive, preserve, protect and so practise Limbo dancing, thereby allowing future generations to endow it as the National Dance of Trinidad and Tobago in particular, and the Caribbean, in general.

Archbishop Charles Jason Gordon was born in 1959. He graduated from Fatima College and subsequently took over the family business consequent to the untimely passing of his father. In 1981, he entered the Living Water Community, where he began his spiritual journey. Shortly thereafter he commenced his seminary formation at the Seminary of St. John Vianney and the Uganda Martyrs, Mount Saint Benedict.

Five years later, Archbishop Gordon graduated with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Theology with First Class Honours from the University of the West Indies (UWI). He also earned a Master's degree in Theology and a Bachelor of Arts in Philosophy from the Catholic University of Leuven in Belgium. In 1991, he was ordained as a priest and completed the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) from Heythrop at Jesuit College, University of London. He was ordained as Bishop of Bridgetown, Barbados and installed as Bishop of the Diocese of Bridgetown, and also served as the Vice President of the Antilles Episcopal Conference of Bishops (AEC) and Chair of the Evangelisation Commission (EC).

In the sphere of academia, His Grace has lectured in Theology, and has taught Caribbean History, Social Ethics, Media and Caribbean Technology. He was also the Principal of the Caribbean School of Catholic Communications, Arima, Trinidad. He founded the Community Intervention Transforming Youth (CITY) programme, to assist with community development. The CITY project engaged numerous stakeholders including the City of Port of Spain and the Trinidad and Tobago Olympic Committee, both of which honoured him for his initiative.

Among his numerous achievements is his delivery of the prestigious Carl J. Peter Lecture on Preaching, at the North American College in Rome, and the Homily at the Official Ecumenical Service of the 2017 G20 Meeting in Hamburg, Germany. In addition to presenting a paper at the CARIFESTA XIII Symposium on Caribbean culture and identity, His Grace has a number of publications related to his faith. Archbishop Gordon's service to the Catholic community includes social justice appointments, religious guidance for both print media and television, hosting of workshops and providing training in theology and spirituality. His Grace also implemented the Trinidad Chapter of the Global Catholic Climate Movement to address the impact of global warming in this country. In Trinidad, Mr. Waithe continued his contribution to academia and culture as the Music Teacher at Belmont Boys' Secondary School. He later joined The University of Trinidad and Tobago's Academy for the Performing Arts as Senior Instructor - Steelpan.

While serving as Musical Director of the Exodus Steel Orchestra, he triumphantly led the Exocubs Junior Steel Orchestra to the Junior Panorama title in 2001. Mr. Waithe was also Musical Director of the bp Renegades Steel Orchestra, arranging and conducting the band's performances at the La Folle Journée de Nantes Festival in France from 2008-2020, as well as their performances in Japan and Germany. Under his directorship, the Marionettes Chorale was twice awarded Best Choir at Music Festivals in both England and Trinidad.

Desmond Waithe, for his contribution to culture, was the recipient of the Humming Bird Medal (silver) in 1993, three (3) Cacique Awards and awards from the Tunapuna Piarco Regional Corporation and the City of Port of Spain.

# **Annette Cecile Nicholson- Alfred**

Mrs. Annette Cecile Nicholson-Alfred was born in Charlotteville and attended Charlotteville Methodist Primary School and Bishop's High School, Tobago. She later gained her Trained Teachers' Diploma at Mausica Teachers' College and a Master of Arts in Educational Theatre at New York University.

Mrs. Nicholson-Alfred began her professional career as part of the Ministry for Tobago Affairs, and then transitioned to the field of education, serving in different capacities at a number of institutions including Scarborough Methodist Primary School, Scarborough Secondary School and Sandilands Primary School in the Bahamas.

In 1981, she returned to public service as a Cultural Officer at the Tobago House of Assembly (THA), a position well suited, given her appreciation of the country's culture and heritage. Among her many achievements, Mrs. Nicholson-Alfred co-ordinated the Plymouth/Bethesda Best Village Group, was an outstanding member of the Mausica Teachers' College Alumni Folk Group and the Founder of the Tobago Academy of Performing Arts (TAPA). In 2001, under her guidance, TAPA won the World Folk Dance trophy in Wales, UK, and was also credited as the first to introduce the art of ballet and tap dancing to Tobago.

In 1975, Mrs. Nicholson-Alfred won the Prime Minister's Best Village awards for 'Best Actress' and 'Best Playwright' awards and also received a Best Village scholarship to study drama. She played a pivotal role in conceptualising the Tobago Heritage Festival, eventually serving on the committee for nineteen (19) years. As Leader, her mas band won Tobago Band of the Year ten (10) times.

Mrs. Nicholson-Alfred has served as an insightful resource of all things cultural, having introduced a number of programmes over the years, not only to the THA's lineup, but also directly to the community. Later in her career, she founded the Itsy Bitsy Playhouse and Folk Theatre in 2007, as an ode to Tobago's folklore.

As a cultural activist, she was awarded the Public Service Medal of Merit (Gold) in 2005.

## President

## Honoris Causa

A term used especially of a degree awarded without examination (Honorary Doctorate); one given as a mark of esteem, often represented by the term (*h.c.*) after one's name.

## Graduand/Graduate

A graduand is a person who is about to receive an academic degree, whereas a graduate is a person who, having successfully completed a course or programme of study, is awarded an academic degree.

## Cum Laude

Latin for “with praise” or “with distinction”; denoting or holding a university degree achieved with a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) between 2.70 and 2.99.

## Magna Cum Laude

Latin for “with great praise” or “with great distinction”; denoting or holding a university degree achieved with a cumulative GPA between 3.00 and 3.69.

## Summa Cum Laude

Latin for “with highest praise” or “with highest distinction”; denoting or holding a university degree achieved with a cumulative GPA between 3.70 and 4.00.

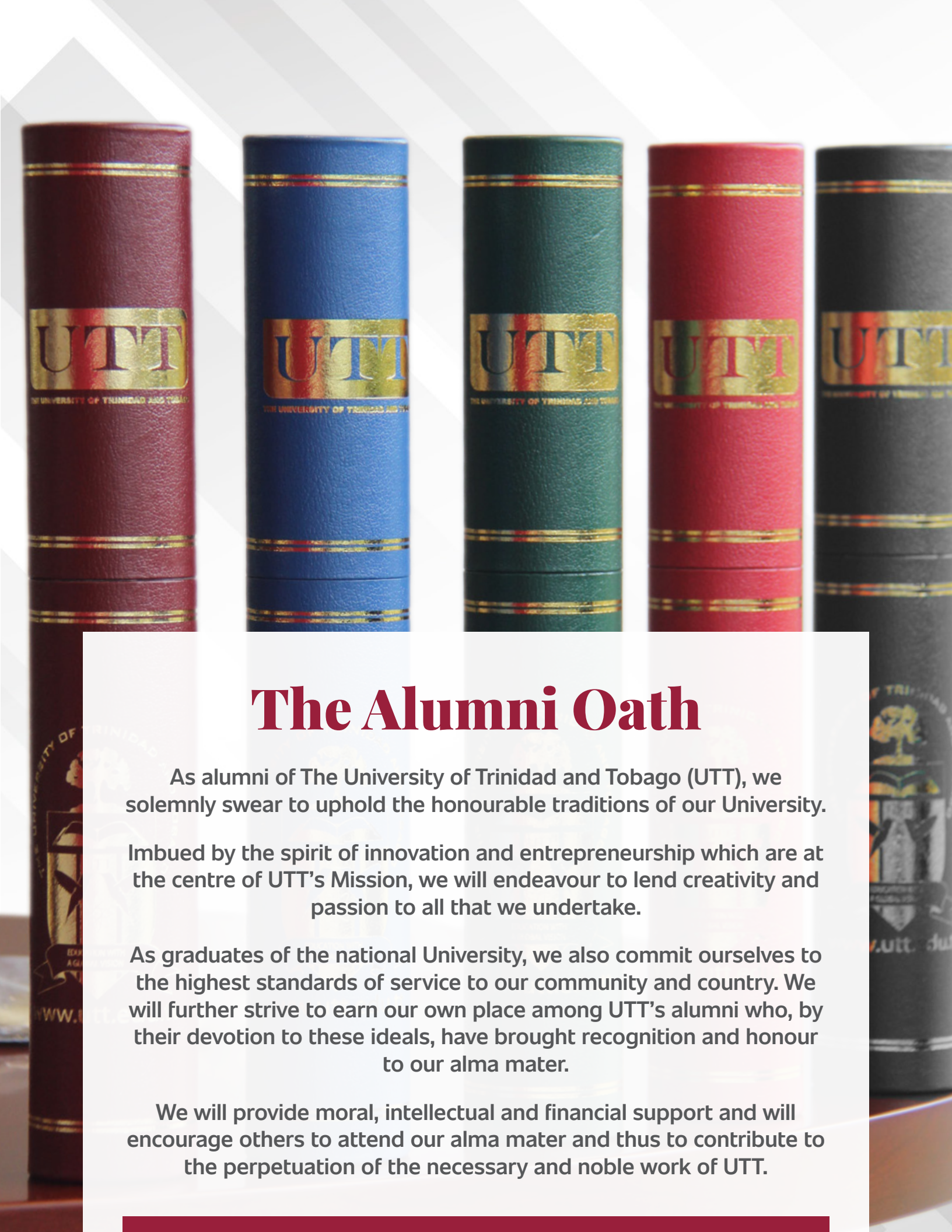

As alumni of The University of Trinidad and Tobago (UTT), we solemnly swear to uphold the honourable traditions of our University.

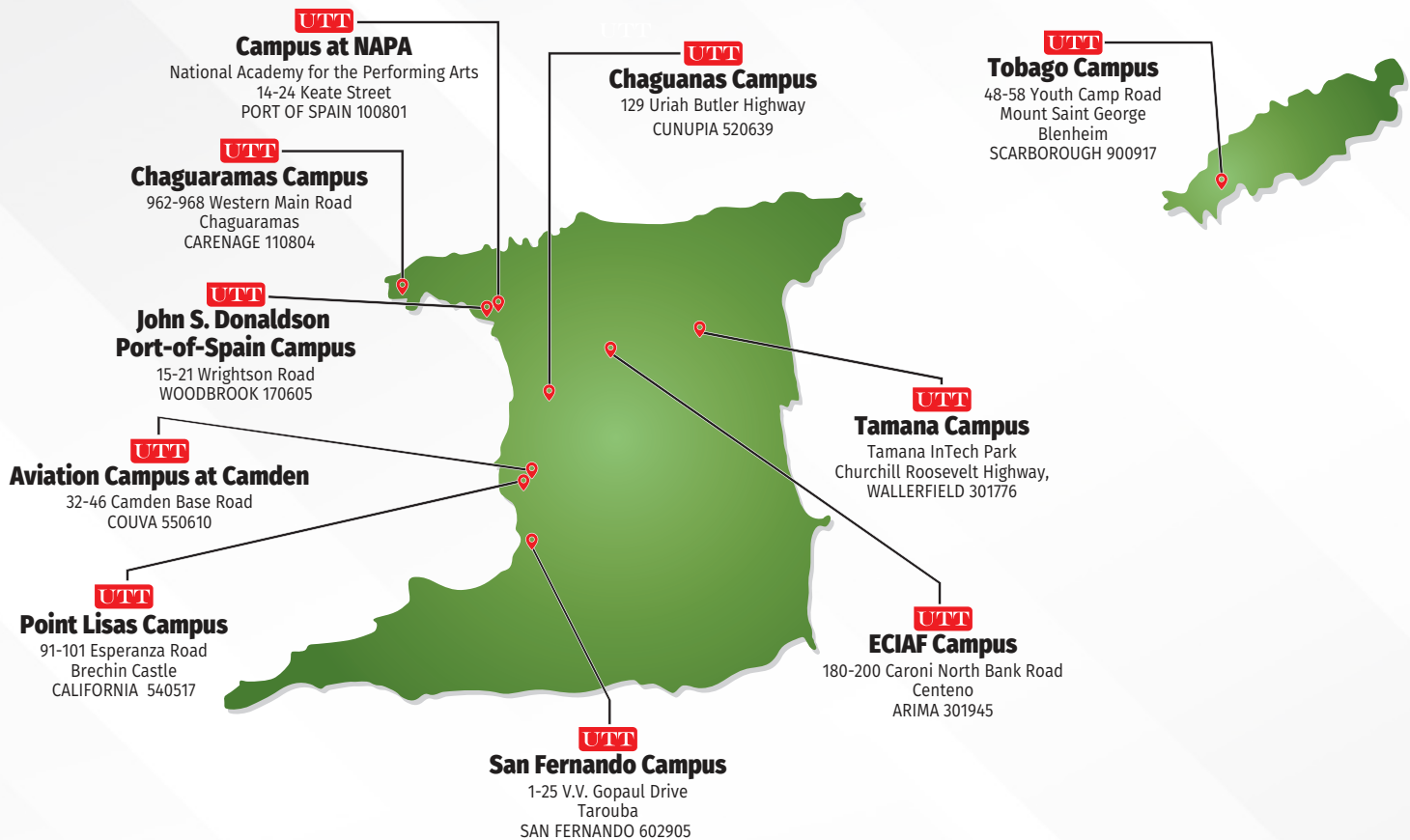
