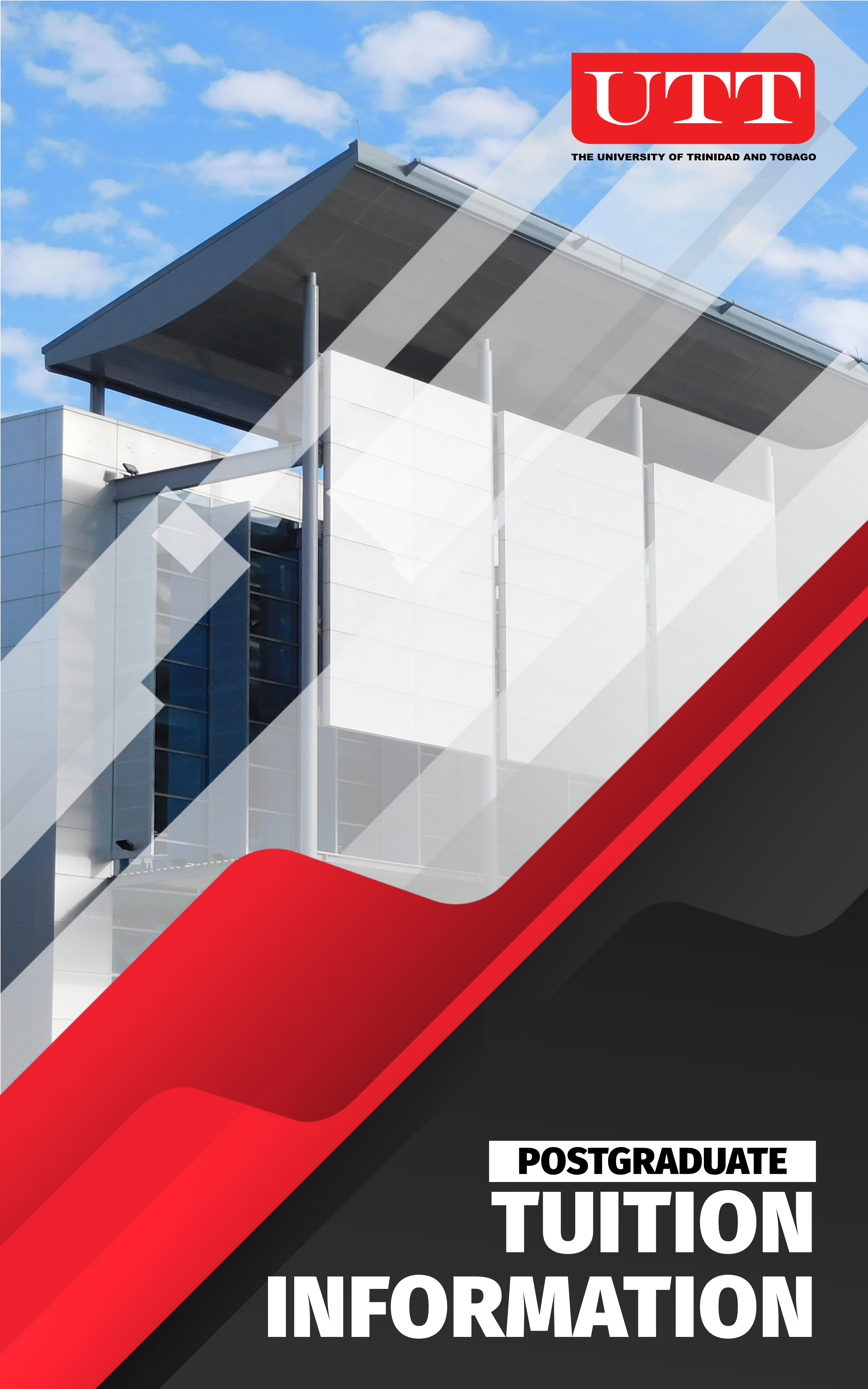

UTT's Tuition Payment Plan

Payment of all tuition and auxiliary (miscellaneous) fees become an obligation when students enrol and register for programmes at UTT. Tuition payments are due by September 30th and February 28th of each year, respectively.

The University offers the Tuition Payment Plan (TPP) as an alternative to paying the tuition fees in full at the start of each academic year, allowing students to pay their tuition in installments in accordance with a set schedule.

All UTT students who are registered and have their accounts in good standing are eligible to apply for the TPP.

The plan is administered on a semester-by-semester basis with all tuition fees being paid in three (3) installments on or before the payment deadlines. It is the student's responsibility to monitor their accounts and ensure that their payments are made in accordance with the schedule.

The schedule for payment is as follows:

INSTALLMENTS	SEMESTER 1	SEMESTER 2
First Installment	1/3 of tuition due on last working day of September	1/3 of tuition due on last working day of February
Second Installment	1/3 of tuition due on last working day of October	1/3 of tuition due on last working day of March
Third Installment	1/3 of tuition due on last working day of November	1/3 of tuition due on last working day of April

Additionally, there is a \$75.00 non-refundable service fee due each semester.

Late Fees

Late payments will be subject to a fee as determined by the University and restrictions may be enforced for each late payment or any payment that does not cover the full installment. Full payment of any previous balance is due prior to registration at the start of the semester.

Outstanding Fees

Any student with an outstanding balance will not be allowed to participate in registration of courses for a future semester until the account is paid in full. The University has the right to take action to collect the balance, including but not limited to the following:

- Prohibiting a student from enrolling in classes in the following semester.
- Withholding courses credit, course grades, academic transcript and graduation certificate until the balance is paid.
- Taking legal action to collect the balance due.

The Postgraduate Diploma in Education is a one-year part-time teacher preparation programme for both in-service and pre-service teachers who already hold a bachelor's or master's degree in several academic domains necessary for teaching in the Trinidad and Tobago education system. These domains range from Mathematics and Science, to disciplines in the Humanities including Social Studies, History, Geography, Sociology and other related fields.

Carnival Studies

The Master in Arts in Carnival Studies will focus on Carnival as both a historical product, and the evolution and development of cultural practices that are unique to the multi-cultural society of Trinidad and Tobago. It will provide a lens through which students will come to understand the richness, aesthetic, beauty and depth of the festivities relevant to carnival in particular, and to the oral traditions of Trinidad and Tobago in general. Courses to be studied will include, Caribbean History and Civilisation, Proseminar in Ethnomusicology (to include the history and evolution of Carnival music and instrumentation), Caribbean Carnival and Culture: the management, business features, development and spread of Carnival at home and abroad.

It is designed for persons who wish to explore careers as education software/games developers; E-Learning consultants; educational video producers; instructional designers; technology support specialists; teachers; web and/or multimedia designers; distance learning developers; content development specialist; and learning management systems developers.

The Master of Science in Energy Engineering with Specialisation in Renewable Energy is designed for students with an Engineering or equivalent degree in Petroleum Geoscience or Natural Science. The aim of the programme is to produce graduates with a specialty in Energy Engineering, who would be immediately useful in the upstream petroleum sector, the downstream process industries, the emerging renewable energy industries and elsewhere in the energy value chain. This specialty would be engineering based for the major renewable energy options and in addition, include Sustainable Energy Policy formulation, supplemented by key skills related to Data Science.

There must be an oral defence of the Thesis.

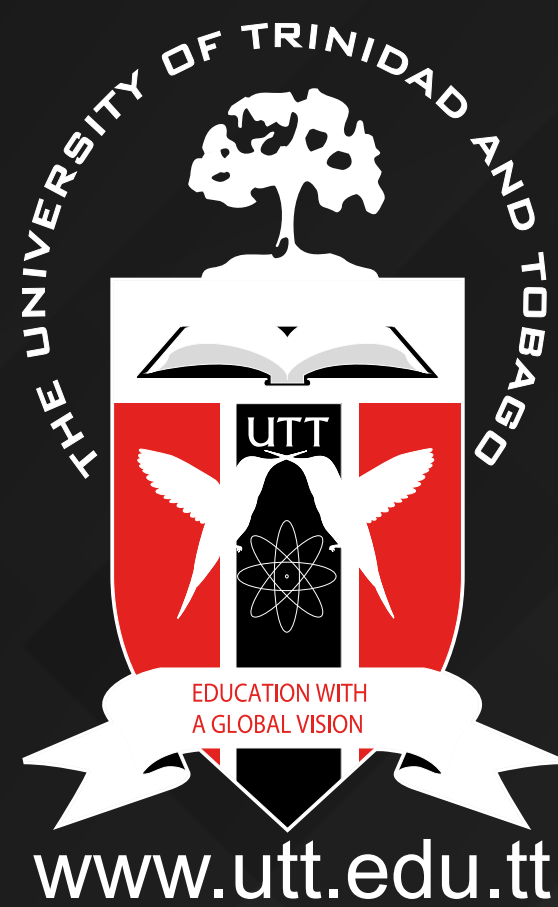
